

Final Examination Schedule - Fall 2020

Please note that due to changes for the Fall 2020 term from the COVID-19 virus, adjustments have been made to the exam schedule. The Exams are scheduled Saturday, Dec. 5, through Friday, Dec. 11, according to the first day of the week the class meets. Exams will not be scheduled within the exam periods, but should be held on the days noted in the chart to reduce potential conflicts for students. For example, a 9:00 MWF class first meets on Monday; therefore, the exam day can be found by looking in the “Monday” column below. Examinations for 9:30 a.m. Monday classes are given on Monday, Dec. 7.

For classes that are online without a specified meeting day and time, the instructor will schedule the final exam.
